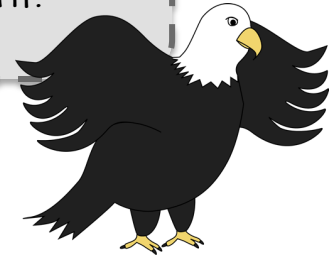


The words **the**, **a**, and **an** are special adjectives called articles.
