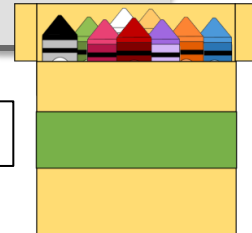


This, that, these, and those are special adjectives that tell how many and how close.
