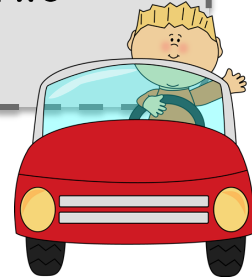


You can use adjectives to compare more than two nouns.
