


What are landforms?

Earth is made of many layers. The top layer is called crust. The crust comes in different shapes.




What are landforms?

An island is a piece of land that is surrounded by water.




Islands

A cave is an opening in the Earth's surface.




COVES

Mountains

A mountain is land that rises above the ground. mountains are made of rock.



Some mountains stand alone. Some mountains are close together. A group of mountains is called a range.

Volconoes

A volcano is a mountain with a hole at the top.



Some volcanoes erupt. Hot, liquid rock called lava can come out of the hole at the top of the volcano.

A hill is lower than a mountain but is higher than its surrounding areas.



Hills

It is usually neither too hot nor too cold in the hills. This makes hills perfect tourist destinations.





A valley is a low area of land between mountains or hills.



Volleys

Valleys can have streams, rivers or even glaciers at the bottom.





A plain is a large area of flat land with few trees.



Plains

Most large cities can be found in plains. This is because it is easier to build houses, buildings, roads and other structures in the plains.



Plateaus

A plateau is a high, flat area of land. It is also called a tableland since it looks like a table.

Plateaus are usually surrounded by steep rock faces called cliffs.
