What Should My Child be Learning this Week?

Reading: Summarizing stories they are reading and noticing characters' points of view (using characters thoughts, feelings and actions in a story to understand what a character thinks about a particular topic).

Phonics: /ow/ sound

Grammar: Introducing pronouns (I, you, she, he, it, we, they, anyone, everything)

Writing: Responding to reading, using details from the story, complete sentences, proper punctuation and correct spelling of high frequency words and words written in the story.

Math: Understanding number stories. We want students to go beyond picking out the numbers and finding key words. We want them to understand what is happening and *why* they should add or subtract.

Science/Social Studies: We want students to explore, practice learning new things and observe the world around them. Have some fun with this!
